### Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on September 8, 2020 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Russ Patrick, Dave Charles, Gina Rusciolelli, Joe Bartley, Jim Mileham, and Mayor Tom Rader. Trustee Michelle Landess was absent.

They are recommending that everyone stay at their vehicle, be aware of social distancing and wear face coverings when social distancing cannot be maintained. Trustee Bartley, chairperson of the Economic Development Committee, stated that the truck stop is working on the entrances, the gutters should be complete this week and the road paved next week. The fuel tanks are ordered and then they will break ground. They are planning an April 1, 2021 opening.
