## Minutes

Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their special board meeting on August 29, 2022 at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees: Dave Charles, Gina Rusciolelli, Joe Bartley, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Tom Rader. Trustee Russ Patrick was not in attendance.

Village Engineer Kevin Kuhn gave an update on USDA Rural Loan bids and projects. The bids were expected to come in at 1.8 million, but came in at 3.6 million dollars for water and sewer projects. One project did not receive a bid (Brine tank). Trustees discussed options to cover the gap in costs including raising base rates on water and sewer projects, discussing projects, and using TIF funds when available. The Trustees will bring these options to committee meetings to discuss and determine further action. Trustee Landess made a motion to continue moving forward with USDA Rural Loan. Trustee Mileham seconded. Trustees Charles, Bartley, Mileham and Landess voted yes. Trustee Rusciolelli voted no.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to approve Ordinance #22-17 An Ordinance Approving Amendments To The Riverton Code of Ordinances Relating To Liquor Licenses. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Charles, Rusciolelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to approve the dates for Riverton's Sesquicentennial for July 27-29, 2023. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Charles, Rusciolelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. Plans are being developed to include the car show, parade, Little Miss, Meet the People from Riverton, bands, vendors, and silent auction all held at the Field of Dreams.

Trustees reviewed the "Non-Architectural Barrier Checklist for Rural Development Loan".

Mayor Rader thanked Kevin, Stacy and Don for all of their work for the USDA Loan.

Trustee Bartley made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:53 pm. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Charles, Rusciolelli, Bartley, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
